We are thrilled and proud to have been selected to photograph you at the 2012 Competition in your Region.

The weekend will be a very busy time for all of you and it will help a lot if you think of your photo needs prior to coming to Competition.

We will only have a short time together in the pattern so preplanning is vital. To best use this time, we ask that you think about what pose you would like. You may have a very specific idea (bring a sample if you have one) or just a general idea, such as full-length or close-up. It helps us come up with ideas if we know what you have in mind.

We have some new ideas including the high angle shots from above (does wonders for chins), floor poses and others. View the gallery and see if any of these poses appeals to you. Upon arrival in the photo room you want to tell the photographer, "Pose #9". This will save a lot of your valuable time.

Please fill the order form attached to this PDF and bring it with you to the photo room in the pattern. Please bring a check for the amount of the order. You may give it to your hostess to hold during the pattern and tell them to hand it to us when you arrive, this will allow you to concentrate on singing. If you don't hand in this form you will then have to use the "Reorder Form, which is more expensive.

Delivery will be in 2 to 3 weeks via Priority Mail.

The photographs we take are protected by copyright. If you wish to use our images for publicity or promotions you need to purchase the publicity CD for \$15. You will get a web friendly image file and the license to use the images for publicity purposes only. This CD will no allow you to print photos for personal use.
